

7-9 November, 2010, Expo Centre, Karachi

Stamp Society of Pakistan [SSOP] in collaboration with the Dawn Group, Pakistan Post and under the patronage of Philatelic Federation of Pakistan [PFP] organized National Stamp Exhibition titled "Pakistan 2010" from 7-9 November, 2010 at Expo Centre, Karachi. This was largely attended on all 3 days and the 80 Frames exhibition attracted crowed of all ages. This exhibition was supposed to be held on 5-7 November but due to security reasons in Karachi it was shifted to 7-9 November, 2010 resulting in reduction of exhibits also.

The exhibition included 30 entries from all over Pakistan which were judged on competitiveness in 6 different classes, (i) Traditional (ii) Postal History (iii) Postal Stationery (iv) Thematic (v) Revenue and (vi) Youth. Mr. Abdul Wahid was the Commissioner General of the Exhibition; whereas, the Jury comprised of Syed Imtiaz Hussain (President of the Jury), Mr.Usman Ali Isani, Mr.Rafeeq Kasbati and Mr.M.Jamil Ahmad, who were the Member of the Jury. Unfortunately, Mr. Jamil Ahmad was not present at the Exhibition due to the security concerns.

This was the 5th International Standard National Stamp Exhibition at Expo Centre. This exhibition had World class arrangements and the large picturesque setting, Video Presentation, wall skins, seating sofas for study and deliberations, which attracted the visitors on all three days.

For the first time ever in the History of Asia, a stamp was printed on the Children's Day (November 5) which was selected from the Live Stamp Drawing Competition organised by the Stamp Society of Pakistan. This design was made by the young talented artist, Ilma Tariq, student of St. Patrick's High School and College.

The autographs of her were taken at Philatelic Counter by the Philatelists and the large number of crowd. Interviews by the T.V channels were also conducted with her family. She also participated in the Drawing Competition.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank Mr. Fazli Sattar Khan, *Additional Director General* (Operations), for extending help in getting the stamp approved for the youth stamp drawing competition and this is indeed a landmark in all the FIAP exhibitions or FIP exhibitions. This will indeed go a long way in boosting the hobby among the younger generation and the artists in particular. We would also like to thank him for giving direction for the usual courtesies and for putting up a stall of the Pakistan Post together with their specimen on the frames.

The Stamp Drawing Competition for children was also largely attended which was divided in two age groups. The first age group (4-10) competition was held on the first day of the exhibition and the next day for the second age group (11-16). Children of Two group participated for 2 hour duration resulted in some excellent drawings. They were given gift hampers at the end of the duration and this was appreciated by the participant's Parents and Principals of Schools. The drawings were judged by Mr. Adil Salahuddin, the renowned Ex-Security Printing Corporation, Head of stamp production and currently General Manager of Pakistan Post Foundation Press, who has been awarded Pride of Performance Award by the Government of Pakistan.

The medals and certificates were given to the exhibitors. The design of the Medal alongwith the copy of Certificate is as per **Annexure-A** attached.

The senior management of DAWN Group, Mr. Hameed Haroon (CEO-Dawn Group), Mr. Ali Hasan Naqvi (Senior Assistant General Manager) and senior officials of the Postal Administration, Mr. Ali Ahsan Farooqi (Post Master General), Mr. Shahid Iqbal (Deputy Post Master General), Mr. Jaleel Siddiqui (Chief Post Master Karachi City G.P.O) and Syed Mohammad Afaq (Chief Post Master Karachi G.P.O) deserve all our appreciation and we should commend their contribution throughout the three day exhibition and their support in holding such a great stamp exhibitions.

Pakistan Post issued three special cancellations one on each day of Exhibition (i) Children's Day (ii) UPU Day & (iii) Award Day on 7th, 8th & 9th November 2010, respectively. A dedicated Philatelic Counter of Pakistan Post was established at the Exhibition Hall for the issuance of Special Cancellations and sale of philatelic material. Mr. Ali Ahsan Farooqi (Post Master General), Mr. Shahid Iqbal (Deputy Post Master General), Mr. Jaleel Siddiqui (Chief Post Master Karachi City G.P.O) and Syed Mohammad Afaq (Chief Post Master Karachi G.P.O) were present during the Exhibition and at the Palmaris Dinner at Defence Authority Club.

A beautiful Souvenir of 80 pages was also issued for Pakistan 2010 which consisted of the various articles, National stamp exhibition results from 2003, upcoming exhibition, etc. This effort was highly appreciated by the Philatelist, Pakistan Post and the senior members of Pakistan Philatelic Federation, Mr. U.A.G Isani, Mr. Rafiq Kasbati, Syed Imtiaz Rizvi and Mr. Tariq Khattak.

Stamp Dealers had three full fledged stalls at the Exhibition Hall where a large number of philatelic material, coins, banknotes and publications were available for sale to enthusiasts.

To promote development of Stamp drawing the design competition among the young and budding artist from different Schools of Karachi, for 4 to 10 years was on day one with 40 participants followed by 11 to 16 years on day two with 38 participants. Prizes for 1st to 3rd were awarded in both categories.

SSOP & **PFP** hosted dinner for the **Exhibitors** on Tuesday, 9 November 2010 at 8:00pm Defence Authority Club, Central Avenue, Phase-II, D. H. A, Karachi.

Prize distribution for the children for the design competition and exhibitors was held on the last day, Sunday, 9 November 2010 at the Exhibition Hall, Expo Centre, Karachi. Representatives of PFP, SSOP and Pakistan Post alongwith a large number of enthusiasts, collectors and exhibitors and parents were present. Medals, Certificates and Special Prizes were given alongwith the copy of the Souvenir for PAKISTAN 2010. The senior exhibitors, jury members, senior officials of Pakistan Post and Dawn Group were also given the awards the same day.








